Please arrive NLT 0930

on the Saturday you plan to shoot

(1st and 3rd Saturdays of each month).

When you arrive at the NASK front gate, notify security that you are going to the Skeet and Trap Field.

Alert security that you have a weapon and present your CLEOC paperwork.

After you enter the base, proceed to the security parking lot (BLDG 4728) and meet the Field Safety Officer, Captain Spitzer (305-962-5657). He will escort you to the field.

Price per round (25 clay targets) is \$5.00 for eligible patrons and \$8.00 for quests.

Permits/receipts for rounds are purchased at Community Recreation (BLDG 3783) during regular business hours.

The Skeet and Trap Field opens at 0930 on the first and third Saturday of each month and closes immediately after the final shooter completes their round.

Shooters <u>must</u> purchase rounds <u>and</u> schedule/notify Community
Recreation staff <u>by COB the Friday</u>
<u>prior</u> to their intended shoot date.

Shooters <u>must provide</u> their own shotguns and shells, double hearing and eye protection, and wear closed toe shoes. Shooter <u>minimum age is</u> 10 years old and all minors <u>must</u> be accompanied by an adult.

Required Paperwork

All those that enter the Skeet and Trap Field must have a signed waiver on file with Community Recreation (only legal guardians may sign on behalf of minors).

All those 18 years old and older that wish to shoot, or accompany a shooting minor, <u>must</u> have a current background check **and** their weapon registered with security. Each weapon's registration (CLEOC) paperwork <u>must</u> be on hand when shooting.
